## Make a Flag Assignment

Now that we have discussed the symbolism and significance of the Canadian Flag you are going to create your own version of the Canadian Flag! Be prepared to explain your flag and to give reasons for why you chose to design your flag the way you did.

To clarify, you must:

- Create your own personal version of the Canada Flag on a provided piece of white paper
- Be sure to use symbols and colours that you think represent your personal sense of Canadian identity as explored last class
- Provide a Rationale on the back of your flag that is $\mathbf{8}$ to $\mathbf{1 0}$ sentences long and in paragraph form
- Make sure your Rationale explains (a) what symbols and colours on your flag represent (b) why you think your flag represents Canada

You will be marked according to the rubric on the reverse. You can create a rough draft, but a good copy must be handed in on provided white paper.
